



ADULT LEADERSHIP TRAINING

This should be read in conjunction with the “Module Matrix – Summary of The Scout Association’s Adult Training Scheme”

Modules 1 – 3 must be completed for all appointments – Colony/Pack/Troop Assistant and Leaders

Modules 1 & 2 must be completed within 3 months of appointment.
Module 3 must be completed within 5 months of appointment.

Leaders must also complete modules 5 – 19

Completion of these modules leads to the award of a Wood Badge. This training should be completed within 3 years.

The training modules can be accessed in a number of ways.

Below is an example of how the training for a leader might be achieved, bearing in mind that this can take place over 3 years. A number of modules can be combined to make a weekend’s training.

The training can be completed in a variety of ways. Put simply, all the training could be achieved in 6 days plus 3 evenings; or in 4½ days plus 12 evenings; or something in between. And this can be spread over 3 years.

All training is paid for by the Scout Group together with expenses. Uniform is also provided by the Group.
